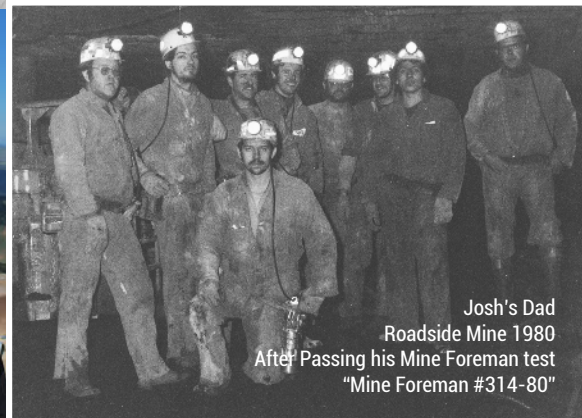

He went on to work with the Colorado Board of Mine examiners and used me for his training and testing practice. Around 2010, the script was flipped, and as I got more involved in Mining and reclamation again – I used my best resource (dad) to guide my understanding and to "think like a mine operator" when providing contracted services.
